Day 1

Transfer to Hotel San Martin (right at the entrance of Iguassu National Park) after your arrival at Iguassu (Brazilian Side).

Day 2

Full day Iguassu (Argentinean Side) tour of one of the wonders of the world. You'll see more than 275 separate falls, literally tons of water hurtling over precipices higher than a 30 story building. In the morning you will depart your hotel to cross the Ponte da Fraternidade (Fraternity Bridge) over the Iguassu River to Argentinean National Park. The full day tour to the Argentinean Falls includes visits to the three circuits – Superior part of the Falls, Devils Throat and the Lower Part of the Falls. Before returning to Brazil, a visit will be made to the shopping district of Puerto Iguassu.

(B) – Buffet

Day 3

Today you will enjoy a morning tour of the Falls – Brazilian side. Located in the Iguassu National Park, one of the largest reserves of sub-tropical jungle, the Cataratas are formed by 240 different cascades. Descend the walkway for about a mile for fantastic panoramic views of the Falls and return by panoramic elevator.

(B) – Buffet

Day 4

In 1994, the American Society of Civil Engineers elected the Itaipu Dam as one of the Seven Wonders of the Modern World; it is the biggest power plant on Earth. The construction started in January 1975 and finished in 1982 and took 30,000 people and 7 years to build the Dam at a cost of twenty billion dollars. Itaipu Dam is almost 5 miles long and 646 feet tall and it generates 75 billion kilowatts of electricity per year. Depart your hotel and pass by downtown Iguassu, arrive at the Visitor's Center of the Dam for a 15 minute movie on the history of the world's largest dam. A visit to the dam itself with a specialized guide will also be made. Late afternoon at leisure.

(B) – Buffet

Day 5

Depart Iguassu and transfer to the airport.
