**Day 1 - Arrival - 17 June 2020**

**Day 2 - Mougins & Grasse - 18 June 2020**

This morning, we make our way to the charming hilltop village of Mougins, renowned for its cuisine and as an inspiration for a host of famous artists. Over time, the village has been the home of many famous individuals including, most famously Pablo Picasso and Winston Churchill. In fact, Picasso's studio is now the village tourist office! We spend time here to browse the shops, galleries (don't miss the Museum of Classical Art) and restaurants. In the afternoon, we re-board our coach to make the short journey to Grasse to visit the famous Fragonard Parfumerie. We will enjoy an interesting tour which will provide us with an insight into the perfume industry in the region. We return to our hotel later in the afternoon.

**Day 3 - Cannes (driver's day off) - 19 June 2020**

Our day today is spent enjoying the chic resort of Cannes, with its famous red carpet and amazing yachts in the marina. With our hotel so close to the famous port, we can enjoy a stroll along the Croisette promenade, some shopping on Rue d'Antibes, or even a boat trip out to the Ile Saint-Marguerite, famous as the legendary location of the Man in the Iron Mask.

We enjoy the morning here browsing the traditional shops and cafés. In the afternoon we travel to the beautiful village of St Paul de Vence, famous as a haven for artists and for traditional Provençal crafts. The medieval village is absolutely stunning with amazing views and a host of small craft shops. Matisse and Picasso would stay at Auberge Colombe d'Or and pay with paintings. Today, the inn is a high-class restaurant and hotel, but many paintings are still on view there. We return to our hotel in the early evening time for dinner.

**Day 5 - Monaco & Èze - 21 June 2020**

We board our coach after breakfast and make the journey to the principality of Monaco. As a country within a country, Monaco retains its own unique feel that really stands out. We will enjoy a short-guided tour of the main sights including the royal Palace, Oceanographic Museum and Casino

After our visit, we will return to Cannes along the famous Corniche coast road, stopping at the beautiful village of Èze, with its medieval center.
