

Kenya – African Safari
May 9 – 16, 2021
7 nights / 8 days

Day 1- Nairobi Arrival

Arrive in Nairobi today, Kenya's vibrant capital. Free time to explore the city or relax at your hotel this afternoon.

Overnight – Nairobi

Day 2- Samburu

This morning depart northward to the Central Highlands to Samburu National Reserve. En route to your lodge enjoy your first game-viewing drive before arriving in Samburu in afternoon. Afternoon safari. Dinner at your lodge tonight.

Overnight – Samburu Game Reserve (B, L, D)

Day 3 - Samburu

A full day of game viewing starts with an early morning safari. This is when the animals are most active. Keep your camera ready, your game spotter will lead you in search of the animals and you'll have plenty of opportunities to photograph your sightings. Return to the lodge for breakfast and relax by the pool and enjoy lunch included at lodge. Sunset safari. Dinner at lodge.

Overnight – Samburu Game Reserve (B, L, D)

Day 4 - Treetops

Drive into the forests of the Aberdare mountain range to Treetops. Treetops Lodge lies in the path of an ancient Elephant migratory route between the Aberdare Ranges and Mt Kenya National park and is strategically sited right in front of a natural watering hole and salt lick, making it the perfect place to view game. Enjoy dinner at your lodge at Treetops.

Overnight – Treetops (B, L, D)

Day 5 – Lake Nakuru

An early morning start will have you arrive at spectacular Lake Nakuru, world renowned for its vast population of pink flamingos. Enjoy a safari as you drive into this area. A second safari at sunset will show you the birdlife that this park is known for you may even see flamingoes.

Overnight – Lake Nakuru (B, L, D)

Day 6 – Masai Mara

Drive to Narok via Mai-Mahiu. Arrive in Masai Mara in time for an afternoon game drive, returning to your hotel as the sun sets. The Masai Mara is the northern extension of Tanzania's famous Serengeti Plains. It is Kenya's premier place of seeing wildlife, and home to a thriving population of predators such as lion and cheetah, as well as hippo, crocodile, zebra, giraffe, elephant, wildebeest and impala. There are no fences around your lodge and it is not uncommon to see elephant and buffalo roaming around the perimeter of your hotel grounds!

Overnight – Masa Mara (B, L, D)

Day 7 – Masai Mara

Included in today's program are additional morning and late afternoon safaris led by your game spotter who will take you in search of the Big Five: elephant, lion, buffalo, leopard and the much rarer rhino. In between game drives, relax at your comfortable lodge, take a dip in the pool and enjoy the delicious food served. This evening join your fellow travelers for a farewell dinner. Optional hot air balloon ride at sunrise.

Overnight – Masai Mara (B, L, D)

Day 8 – Nairobi

After breakfast, depart Masai Mara and head across acres of wheat and barley farms. You'll likely see giraffe and gazelle. Arrive in Nairobi early afternoon. Travelers can depart on flights departing this afternoon or evening.
